

Snow Family Scholarship Application

The Snow Family Scholarship Fund, established in 2024 by Jessica and Bruce Snow and managed by the CenDel Foundation, recognizes and supports outstanding Smyrna High School senior(s). The scholarship provides tuition assistance to students pursuing higher education at a two- or four-year college, university, or trade school.

ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Must be a Smyrna High School Senior(s)
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 at the time of graduation.
- Must demonstrate a financial need.
- Must be an active member of Future Farmers of America (FFA)
- Must pursue a 2- or 4-year degree program at an accredited college/university or an accredited trade school.
- Must demonstrate good character and actively participate in community service or extracurricular activities.

GENERAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION:

- Financial assistance is accessible in July before the fall semester upon the submission of proof of enrollment (tuition bill and class schedule) to the CenDel Foundation.
- Additionally, this scholarship is not renewable.
- Awards will be mailed directly to the college/ university or accredited trade school.

DEADLINES:

- Applications must be submitted on 2026 grant application and submitted by Monday, March 16, 2026, to be eligible for consideration for awards in the following academic year.
- 2026 Applications will be available at Smyrna High School's Guidance Department and online at www.cendelfoundation.org under the "Apply for a Grant" tab.

AWARDS:

- The Snow Family Scholarship will award two \$1,200 scholarships in 2026.
- Applicants will receive notification of the award in the spring of 2026. (grant is not renewable).
